- + Bug hotels: A bug hotel is a manmade structure created to provide shelter for insects. They come in a variety of shapes and sizes and are great for attracting different types of minibeast such as ladybirds, bees, woodlice and spiders. You might even get frogs or hedgehogs coming to stay.

Even if small businesses lack the resources for detailed tracking, it's still important to measure the benefits of nature-based solutions over time. Here are some straightforward, practical ways to assess the impact:

- + **Energy savings:** Monitor your bills to see if natural cooling from green roofs or walls have reduced your heating or cooling costs. Over time, these savings can add up.
- + **Customer and employee feedback:** Ask employees and customers about their experience with your nature-based solutions. This feedback can help highlight improvements in employee well-being and customer satisfaction.

+ Biodiversity: Keep an eye on your green spaces to see if they are attracting pollinators like bees, butterflies, or birds. Noticing more wildlife around your business is a great indicator that your nature-based solutions are contributing to urban biodiversity. You could even encourage employees to take part in a wildlife survey, for example The Big Butterfly Count.
