+ PROGRESS & INFO

A flourishing life on land is the foundation for our life on this planet. We are all part of the planet's ecosystem and we have caused severe damage to it through **deforestation**, **loss of natural habitats** and **land degradation**. Promoting a sustainable use of our ecosystems and preserving biodiversity is not a cause. It is the key to our own survival.

As of February 2021, 127 countries and territories had committed to setting voluntary targets for achieving land degradation neutrality, and 68 countries and territories had already officially endorsed their targets.



+ THE ROLE OF BUSINESSES

The following business themes are addressed by SDG 15:

- Protect natural ecosystems.
- Prevent degradation of natural ecosystems
- Finance the protection of natural ecosystems
- Value and respect natural capital

The role of businesses, at a minimum, should be to respect all applicable environmental laws governing pollution, land use, and life on land.

The scope for business leadership is significant within SDG 15. This leadership involves understanding and valuing natural ecosystems, verifying that activities across internal operations and the value chain will not negatively impact ecosystems, and innovating and providing finance for preservation and enhancement of ecosystems.

BUSINESS ACTIONS

- Implement **office recycling schemes** for paper, glass, plastic, metal and old electronics.
- Implement **food waste collection** service in your offices.
- Encourage a paperless office. Go electronic whenever possible.
- Verify that your suppliers and/or partners do not test their products on animals.
- Verify that your suppliers and/or partners are growing plants responsibly and in a sustainable manner.
- Examine the lifecycle of your products to ensure that natural ecosystems are not harmed by activities.



ADDITIONAL ACTIONS

- Find a Goal 15 **charity** you want to support.
- Support or partner with conservation projects, either locally or internationally.
- Organise your own or join an existing **clean-up event** to sustain the ecosystem of your local green space.
- Develop and support environmental education programs aimed at raising awareness about the importance of biodiversity and ecosystem services. This could be directed towards schools or local communities.
- Advocate for and support policies that promote sustainable land use and protect vital ecosystems. This might involve engaging with policymakers or participating in public forums on environmental legislation.
- Invest in green infrastructure, like creating green roofs, urban gardens, or green walls, which can support local biodiversity and provide ecosystem services in urban areas.
- Invest in **research** to develop compounds that can replace unsustainable agricultural products e.g. palm oil, cocoa, soy.
